- inspecting facility and equipment to ensure safety
- preparing daily/ weekly activity reports, attendance reports, damage reports and accident/incident reports
- maintaining discipline of participants and conducting yourself in such a manner as to enhance the prestige and dignity of your position

- High school students aged 16 or older
- Post Secondary education focused in Early Childhood, Education, Kinesiology, Recreation, or other related programs
- Ability to pass vulnerable persons Criminal Record Check

- Play Leadership course (SPRA)
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License
