- Perform motor tune-ups, replacement of worn parts, set to proper adjustment and replace as required
- Safely use acetylene torch
- Diagnose and repair hydraulic systems on motor vehicles
- Undertake and record the servicing of units in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations or workshop policy
- follow safe and proper working procedures and practices
- Available after hours on-call for emergency repairs
- Attend courses to ensure all qualifications are kept current
- Perform related duties as assigned
