Clean Sidewalks Bylaw

Moose Jaw – The City of Moose Jaw reminds residents and business owners of the Clean Sidewalks Bylaw, which contains the following protocols:

1. Sidewalks at all businesses, multi-unit dwellings and other specified areas of the City are to be cleared of snow, ice and other debris daily. Heavy snow must be removed within forty-eight (48) hours after the fall thereof has ceased.
2. It is illegal to deposit snow, ice or debris from private property ie. private driveways, service station lots or parking lots, onto any City street or land.
3. Snow from residential driveways must be placed on that property only. Residential sidewalks are not required to be cleared. If they are, where possible snow should be placed on the abutting property. Otherwise, it may be placed in the gutter beside the sidewalk.
